Jena S. gave an update on the Historic Preservation Kick-Off Meeting held on January 6, 2022. This meeting was held on the topic of a new ordinance that will address certain districts and buildings. Going through the ordinance will take a few meetings before the ordinance goes before the Planning Commission. DESIGN REVIEW AND LAND USE PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. Ordinance No. (TBD) – Series 2022 – An ordinance of the Town of Minturn, Colorado, amending Chapter 16 of the Minturn Municipal Code to provide for the rezoning of the Old Town Residential Zone District, the South Town Residential Zone District, the Martin Creek Residential Estate Zone District, the Cross Creek Residential Zone District, Game Creek Residential Zone District, and the Willow Creek, Rock Creek, and Holy Cross Residential Zone Districts for the Purpose of Aligning with State Statute Concerning Day Care Homes.

Scot H. introduced the ordinance. The state law changed and thus we are amending the Municipal Code to reflect that change. This affects every residential zone district in town. The purpose is to increase access to opportunities to Family Child Care Homes. We will be adding a new section to Chapter 16, Article 17 of the MMC as well as amending the definition of Day Care Center and replacing the definition of Day Care Home with Family Child Care Home.

Jena S. asked that we consider this change for Senior Care as well.

Elliot H. clarified how this affects current child care providers in the Town.

Jena S. clarified if this affected the use table.

Lynn T. asked if there was guidance to how to demonstrate the adequate size of the facility.

• Jena S. said that the State has controls to guide this.

Public Comment was opened and closed.

The Town of Minturn and Vail Valley Mountain Trails Alliance (VVMTA) requests review of a pergola structure to be constructed at Minturn's Bike Park. Per the Applicant's request:

"As part of a CDOT Revitalizing Main Streets Grant, the Town is proposing to install a shelter / shade structure at the Minturn Bike Park."

The Town of Minturn owns the land that the structure will sit on, while the VVMTA will oversee the installation. The pergola is 19.52' by 24.85' situated on the paved patio area at the entrance to the park. The Town of Minturn received funding through a CDOT Revitalizing Main Streets Grant in 2021. The grant project included several items for downtown, but also included the addition of the pergola / shelter structure for the bike park. The pergola is scheduled for installation in the spring once temperatures allow.

Economic Development Coordinator Cindy Krieg has been working with VVMTA for 6 months to bring this project forward through a process. The plans associated with the application have been submitted for the Design Review Board's consideration along with photos showing the location.

Staff is recommending approval without conditions.


